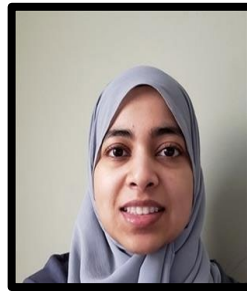

This position will support key activities related to medical information, publications, training, and resource development. The Fellow may support other Medical Affairs activities as needed. Q: When does the Fellowship program start?

A: June 12, 2023

Q: Are there employment opportunities at TerSera after completing the Fellowship?

A: TerSera is a growing pharmaceutical company. Individuals who complete the fellowship would be competitive candidates for relevant open positions, however, we cannot guarantee there will be a position open for the Fellow at TerSera after successful completion of the Fellowship program.

Q: What are the elective components of the Fellowship?

A: Elective offerings of the program can be tailored based on the fellow's interests and will vary based on project availability, preceptor availability, and needs of the business.

Q: Can the Fellow work remotely?

A: Yes, the Fellow can choose to work remotely or be based in the Deerfield office.

Q: Is this Fellowship open to international applicants?

A: Unfortunately, only US citizens can apply.

Q: When will the TerSera Selection Committee make a decision?

A: Select candidates will be invited for virtual interviews with the Selection Committee during the months of October and November. The Selection Committee will inform candidates in early December 2022.
