






Fellows by Department/Functional Area (n=442 Fellows)





More than 80% of pharmacists working in industry today got their first industry role without having completed a fellowship!

Fellowships are highly competitive with only 15% of applicants securing a position.

It is therefore recommended that you pursue both the non-fellowship and fellowship paths simultaneously and prepare yourself for the 85% likelihood that you will not get a fellowship. Prepare early and position yourself to join the >80% of pharmacists currently working in industry who never completed a fellowship program.
